KOLOBE TENTED CAMP FACILITIES



Maximum amount of people is 76

Large Tents – Sleeps 10 people

4 Medium Tents – Sleeps 2 to 4 people

The Russian made tents are waterproof and their design allows natural airflow through the windows and door. The tents are built raised cement slabs, with their own groundsheets to prevent water entering in the event of heavy rainfall.

Each tent is equipped with the following: (Per individual)

- 1 steel bed and mattress
- 1 black chair
- 1 tin trunk (Approximately 700x400x300mm in size) - for the safe keeping of personal belongings

NB: Please note that the camper must bring their own lock & key

Canteen: (12m x 8m):

The canteen is a bricked permanent structure with wooden pillars and a pitched steel roof. Drop down blinds on the sides. The canteen is divided into the cooking area, storeroom and dining area.

Cooking Area:

3 point gas burner (1.4m), 2 point electrical hot plate (no oven), 25lt urn, a chest freezer, a 3 door fridge, dustbins, wash-up facilities, pots, pans & basic cooking utensils.

Each camper must bring their own plate, mug and eating utensils.

Crockery, cutlery and glassware can be provided on request at a fee.

Storeroom:

There is a lock up storeroom, for which the key will remain the responsibility of the

organiser's, for the duration of the stay. There are 3 lockable cupboards in the storeroom, for the safe keeping of personal belongings.

NB: Please ensure you bring your own padlocks.

Canteen Dining Area:

There are 10 x 6 seater wooden A frame bench & tables.

There are 4 x loose six seater tables

The dining area is a lovely space designed for the eating of meals, but it can be used for conferences, team building events, social gatherings, meetings etc.

Professional conference venues are available at Protea Hotel The Ranch; these vary in size and price. Quotes may be requested if required.

PLEASE NOTE:
